



Practical Guide: How to Get to Ávila from Madrid

By TRAIN



Most trains from Madrid to Ávila depart from Príncipe Pío Station (Madrid) <https://goo.gl/maps/GhKqrrpuTztrqqj7>
To get from "Adolfo Suárez" Madrid Barajas Airport to Príncipe Pío train station in Madrid, you can take:



METRO

METRO from Terminal 3, Line **8**, then at Nuevos Ministerios station take Line **10** to Príncipe Pío (with transfer), or



CERCANÍAS TRAIN

CERCANÍAS train (C-1) from Terminal T4 Renfe Cercanías to Príncipe Pío (direct; longer route), or



TAXI

TAXI from Barajas Airport to Príncipe Pío costs approximately €30–€40. From Madrid to Ávila 150 / 200 €.

Direct from Barajas Airport T1 and T4 to Ávila (From Terminals T1 and T4), a bus departs twice daily to Ávila. <http://www.jimenezdorado.com/>
